



100th Anniversary Celebrations

Rules:

- 1. Schools should consider one of the following categories to perform in: Choir, Instrumentalist groups/orchestra, choral speaking, drama, dance.**
- 2. Recording of any performance is strictly prohibited. The use of equipment for the purposes of photography is also strictly prohibited.**
- 3. Only pupils currently attending the school are eligible to participate.**
- 4. No members of staff are permitted to perform with the pupils except when providing an accompaniment.**
- 5. Schools are permitted to submit one entry only.**
- 6. Performances must not exceed 10 minutes.**
- 7. Choirs are expected to provide their own accompanists.**
- 8. Instrumentalist groups/orchestras must provide their own music stands.**
- 9. The use of backing tracks is permitted.**
- 10. Copies of music/scripts should be forwarded to the committee no later than the 14th September 2018. Copies of music will be destroyed after the event unless an original has been submitted. Original copies of music will be returned to the school.**
- 11. Number of participants should be indicated on the entry form. Schools should provide a minimum of 10 pupils and should not exceed 50.**
- 12. Small schools are permitted to amalgamate. This must be clearly indicated on the entry form.**
- 13. Drama groups are permitted to use props and costumes.**
- 14. Participating schools are responsible for transport costs to and from the venue**
- 15. Two entries from each regional area will be invited to participate at the 100th Anniversary Concert held in The Ulster Hall on Tuesday 22nd January 2019.**
- 16. Any school invited to participate at the 100th Anniversary Concert must perform the same act presented at their regional venue.**
- 17. UTU will subsidise travel costs for schools attending the 100th Anniversary Concert. A maximum of £100.00 will be allocated to each participating school. All travel invoices must be forwarded to the committee before any payment can be made.**
- 18. Friends and family of participating groups will be charged a nominal entry fee of £10.00. All tickets are sold on a 'first come first served' basis.**
- 19. All schools should provide a list of participants name on the day of the performance.**
- 20. Protests will not be accepted against the award of the adjudicators as to merit. Their decision shall be final and will be upheld.**
- 21. The decision of the committee, in all matters arising out of or not provided for in these regulations, shall be final.**
- 22. It is the responsibility to supervise their pupils and to be aware of individual and specific needs.**
